



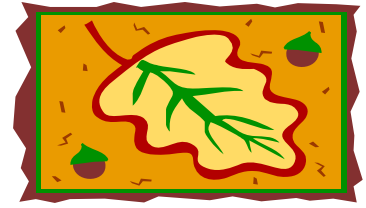
## Studio Policies Reminder

This is just a quick reminder on some of the things that will help our studio stay beautiful and help our classes running smoothly.

- Class observation should be limited to the last 10 minutes of class on the first class of the month. This allows instructors to have complete attention of the class and be the most productive in class. Also please do not observe from the back of the class room. We need that space to dance. If siblings are waiting in the lobby please help us by keeping them occupied with activities so they do not distract the classes.
- All students must be dressed appropriately for class. At no time are jeans proper attire for dance/tumbling

class. This includes dance shoes. Students must wear the proper shoes for each class. If you are coming straight from school please pack your dance clothes/shoes in your backpack. Also Hip-Hop students the tennis shoes you wear for class **SHOULD NOT** be the same shoes you wear to school. **STREET SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE DANCE FLOOR!**

- Parents please be prompt in picking up students at the end of their classes. Especially the last class of the evening. It is not fun to be the last student here, and our instructors need to get home to their families. Thank you in advance for your help in this

## Costume Fees and Account Balances

Over the next 2-3 weeks we will be measuring all the students during class so we can size each student and order costumes. We will be ordering costumes by the end of the year. We will be placing the order right after we close for our Winter Break.

For those families that have been paying an average fee each month on top of your tuition your costumes will be paid in full with your Decem-

ber payment. For those that selected to pay your fees by the due date, please get those payments in by December 21st. We will be closed the rest of the year for our Winter Break. All accounts need to have a 0 balance in order to have costumes ordered for your student. If you do not have a 0 balance or have not paid for a costume, one will not be ordered for your student.

Here is a breakdown of what cos-

tume fees are, so you can calculate what you owe. If you are set-up on Auto-Pay you will need to email Jenny with authorization to charge your card for the costume fee.

# Studio Fundraiser

Dear Santa...

*Ms. Jenny, Ms. Nicole, and Ms. Kim have a wish list... All we want for Christmas is...*

We are wanting to get a new dance floor, finish off our mirrors, and add some new tumbling equipment to our collection.

As we have researched we have found a floor that will benefit all of our students. The type of floor we would like to invest in will be safer, will easily lay on top of our current "sprung" floor, and will be a professional grade floor that will allow the dancers/tumblers an improved surface to work on. The floor we are wanting to get is the type of floor that students will dance on at competitions.

We would like to finish off our mirrors to give our students more room to be able to see themselves work.

And as our Tumbling program grows and the students are starting to learn advanced skills, we would like to add some equipment that will continue to allow them to learn and grow as tumblers.

However, all of these things are going to be a big investment. Instead of raising tuition studio wide, we are choosing to do a Studio Fundraiser. We are asking that all students/families participate so we can all enjoy the benefits.

We have chosen to do the Scratch Card fundraiser. Each card has 40 scratch dots ranging from \$1-\$5 per dot. Each family will get a Scratch Card and will ask friends/family/teachers to scratch off **at least 2 dots**. Underneath will be a \$ amount, the student will then ask to collect the total amount as a donation. No one will ever uncover an amount greater than \$5. Each card costs the studio \$15 to purchase, but when the entire card has been cleared they should have collected \$156 (profiting \$141 per card). For each person that donates money toward your Scratch Card, you will have a coupon sheet to give them, thanking them for their support.

If every family completes 1 card we would raise enough money for Ms. Jenny, Ms. Nicole, and Ms. Kim to get all of their Christmas Wishes granted.

If a student/family absolutely does not want to participate in the fundraiser, we

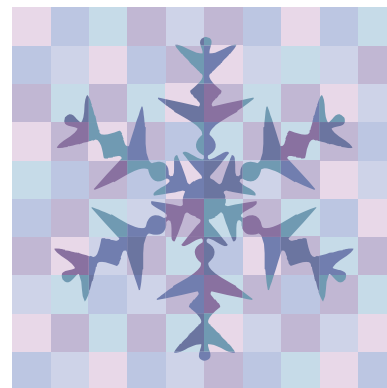
would ask that the student/family donate at a minimum of \$50.

If a student/family clears 1 card and we have any cards left over, they may have a 2nd card and a 3rd if we have enough. After the 1st card is cleared and the money has gone to the studio they may choose to donate the other card(s) to the studio or have the amount profited applied to their account. This is a great way for students to help pay for their costumes fees (which are due).

We have ordered 100 Scratch Cards, so if you absolutely do not want to participate please do not take one as they cost the studio \$15.

**Cards will be passed out as soon as they arrive and must be turned in by Wednesday, December 21st at 8PM (This is the day we close for Winter Break).**

If we raise enough money we will order the floor, the mirrors, and the tumbling equipment over break and hopefully all will be installed by the time we return from Winter Break.
